### Ways to Vote

**Mail in or Absentee ballot** - If you choose to do a mail in ballot, fill out your ballot in **BLUE INK** (*blue is difficult to manipulate*). You can mail it or Take it directly to **Central Processing Center at 965 Trade Drive**. You also have the option to utilize our Secure Drop Off Box at:

**Monday - Thursday 10am - 4pm**

**Electronically by Dominion Machines** - If you choose to cast your vote electronically, you have from May 23rd - June 5th for early voting. It is best practice to vote on Election Day, June 9th. Keep in mind if you wait until election day, lines and wait times could be long.

### Check Your Voting History

You can go onto the SOS website, fill out your personal information and then click at the top header, VOTING HISTORY. Make sure that your most current vote matches. If you turned in your ballot it will say "Mail Ballot Counted", if you voted in person it will tell you "Early Voting" or "Election Day". If your History is incorrect for the Primary Election, fill out an Election Integrity Violation Report with the Secretary of State.
